Bachelor of Business in Hotel & Catering Management (Block Release)

This three year programme provides students with an opportunity to combine working in the hotel or tourism industry with a college education. This national qualification will ultimately lead to an excellent business qualification with a specialism in hotel management.

BA Ordinary Degree in Culinary Arts (part time)

Comprising of one day a week over three years, this programme develops higher technical and artistic knowledge among qualified chef executives who are working in the industry.

Advanced Certificate National Apprentice Professional Cookery Programme (day release)

One day a week for 24 weeks over two years - for all budding commis chefs and chefs de partie. This programme allows students to develop their skills and gain a level 6 qualification in professional cookery while working in the industry. Applicants must be working in the industry and have the support of their employer to participate in this programme.

Have you thought of changing careers? GMIT is inviting applicants for the following unique programme:

Total Immersion Chef Programme (TICP)

Nine month intensive programme comprising of three days per week in college for 24 weeks, and three months of work-based learning. This programme is suited to career changers who have a passion for culinary arts.
