

Stokes Lectureship at GMIT in Biological Science

Post Title: Ecosystem Modelling

Research Environment: The Stokes Lecturer will join the Commercial Fisheries Research Group in GMIT. This group currently comprises twenty three researchers, including three fulltime academic staff, one principal investigator, two postdoctoral fellows and 17 postgraduate students. The group conducts research into a wide range of commercial fish and shellfish species in the areas of stock identification, recruitment, gear technology, stock assessment and management.

Requirements/Background: The successful candidate will hold a PhD in an appropriate field and will be required to develop research capacity within GMIT in the area of Ecosystem Approach to Fisheries Management (EAF). They will have demonstrated performance through the practical implementation of plans that can be used for an inclusive, holistic approach to sustainable management of fisheries, publications in peer reviewed journals and a track record of obtaining funding.
