SPECIFIC MITIGATING ACTIONS REQUIRED FOR ACADEMIC STAFF:

Request that students sit apart when possible	While room capacities will be based on the ventilation rate in each room, we plan to start off with small group teaching only, which will allow for physical distancing of students.
	Request that, where possible, students sit apart from one another and utilize the full size of the room. Students will also be advised of this directly.
Request that students use the sanitizing wipes to sanitize their desk/work surface before and after use.	Sanitising wipes will be available in all rooms.
Ensure student attendance and location within the room is recorded for each lecture/tutorial/practical session. Class Attendance & Location Record	 For contact tracing purposes, we need to record student attendance and location with the lecture room / lab. Attendance and location of each student may be manually recorded if preferred. If using the online form to record attendance, then at the start of each lecture/tutorial/lab remind the students to complete the Class Attendance& Location online form. (This records student name, seat number, room number and time). The form can be completed quickly using a smartphone. Seats will be numbered.
Students working in pairs	Students are permitted to work in pairs, but should be encouraged to maintain physical distancing when possible.
Daily Health Check Form	Remind students to complete this form before arrival on Campus each time.
