i) Not taking up a place

There is no need to respond to your offer email if you are accepting your place.

ii) Defer Policy

There will be no defer facility open to students who wish to defer their place on a postgraduate course. Any student not taking up the place in the current year will have to make a new application for entry the next year.

iii) Viable Enrolment

The commencement of any programme is conditional on there being a viable enrolment.

The Institute reserves the right to cancel the offering of any programme.
