



 - International airports; Dublin Shannon (Clare), Knock (Mayo)
- Population of Galway 250k with 80k (city), Ireland's Capital of Culture European Capital of Culture in 2020; Friendliest City in the world
- Dedicated IO with Senior Ambassadors to cater for the needs of Int'l Students, focusing on student experience
- GMIT merged with our partners in Sligo and Letterkenny to be designated as a Technological University in April 2022




Be aware of scams and always try to verify the authenticity of the property/seller before transferring any funds. Check to see if they are registered with the RTB

- The ATU Student Health Unit provides an acute illness service on-campus
- A consultation with the Nurse or Doctor is free
- Service does not include 'out of hours service'
- You should try register with a GP Practice pre-arrival (underlying illness)
 - Find a GP on the www2.hse.ie
 - Email or Phone GP Practice to Register
 - Some GPs have a 4-5 month waiting list
 - Having Irish Mob Number upon arrival is important to complete the registration process with local GP

Students taking prescribed medications should bring an adequate supply with them to ensure continuity of care.

Arrival at Dublin Airport

- Airports are operating at full capacity since early 2022, prepare for delays/missing luggage
- Two queues at the airport EU and Non-EU
- Prepare documentation for presentation to immigration officer
- Most Non-EU Students will be given 90 days temporary permission once they arrive
- ATU Airport Collection Dates
 - 30th August Bus Leaves Dublin Airport at 2pm
 - 5th September (Time to be confirmed)
 - 11th September (Time to be confirmed)








Online Registration

- Email invitations to register will be sent to most students in early September this will be sent to your personal email IDs
- You must login immediately and provide all your personal details, to enable your ATU Student IT Account
- Our IT Department will then send you a Password (via email) to allow you log into our ATU Student Email Account

Preparing for Immigration Appointment

- IRP Registration costs €300 (cash not acceptable)
- Bank Statement showing minimum €4,500 (Non Visa)
- Valid Passport
- Medical/Health Insurance Certificate
- https://www.gmit.ie/study/international-students/studyingat-gmit/medical-insurance
- Your IRP Card is your re-entry visa if you are visarequiring and leave the state before you register with immigration then you need to re-apply for a new visa
- Travel throughout Europe visitor visa required for UK or Schengen Area
- Please note Ireland and the UK are not in the Schengen Area


Email Communication
