New Students – this will be sent to you by the college when you accept your course in GMIT. In most cases it will begin with the letter G followed by 8 numbers. If not in the main body of the letter it will be above your name /address.

Continuing students – this is the ID on your GMIT student card

PIN

New students - in most cases this will be your date of birth in the 6 digit format DDMMYY. So for example 7th June 1998 will be 070698

If you have ever attended GMIT in the past (for an evening course, a previous programme) you may have a PIN that was set, either by yourself or as part of an automatic PIN generation process, and it may not be your date of birth.

If you are a new student and are having difficulty logging in using ID/DOB please e mail webforstudent@gmit.ie supplying your ID and date of birth and requesting a PIN reset.

NOTE – YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO RESET YOUR PIN YOURSELF UNTIL YOU HAVE SUCCESSFULLY LOGGED IN AND SET A PIN HINT QUESTION!!

Continuing students – your PIN will have been reset by yourself upon initial login. Select Forgot PIN and use the PIN hint question that you set upon initial login to reset your own PIN. If this does not work/you forget the PIN hint question answer please e mail webforstudent@gmit.ie supplying your ID and date of birth and requesting a PIN reset.

You will be brought to an expired PIN page and asked to change your PIN

Where your are asked to Re-enter old PIN enter your date of birth in format DDMMYY

Then supply a new 6 digit PIN number – ensure that it is memorable as you will need this to access web services, for example fee payment, exam results. Re Enter the new PI and select login.
