### Free Parking

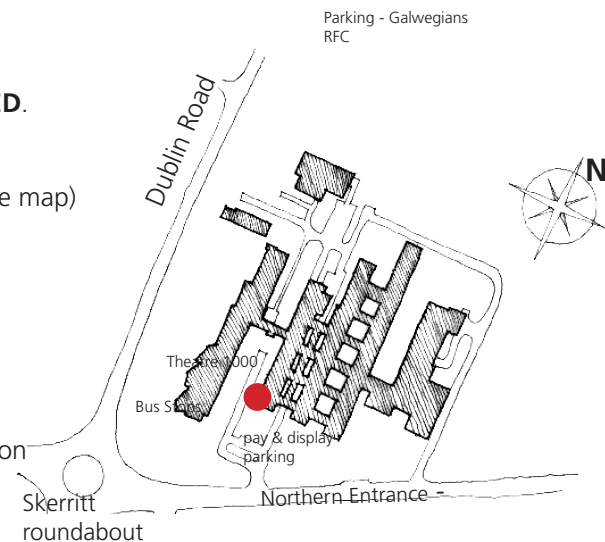
Conference guests may park free in the nearby GMIT, Galwegians Rugby Ground car park, (see map)
