

General:

Students must notify GMIT immediately by emailing covidofficer@gmit.ie or phoning 091 742708 / 0852092713 if:

- A positive test outcome for COVID-19 has been issued by any healthcare provider and are required to quarantine
- Or if they have been identified as a contact and must self-isolate.

Students who develop COVID-19 must follow the advice from their GP and must self-isolate for at least 10 days.

Returning to campus following a positive COVID-19 diagnosis:

You must notify the Covid Officer of your intention to return (by emailing covidofficer@gmit.ie or phoning 091 742708 / 0852092713).

You can return to work/study if these 3 conditions apply to you:

1. You do not live with anyone who is unwell and may have COVID-19.
2. You have had no fever for 5 days – i.e. your temperature has been below 38°C for 5 days (as long as your temperature has not been lowered by taking any form of paracetamol or ibuprofen).
3. It has been 10 days since you first developed symptoms / or 14 days since you first developed symptoms if you have had to attend hospital for treatment for COVID-19.

You must email the Covid Officer (covidofficer@gmit.ie) to verify that the above 3 criteria attach to you and you will then be authorized to return to campus.
