- Most GMIT students were able to attend campus for labs, tutorials, and practicals over the last year. We hope to build on this from September 2021, by scheduling more learning activities on site before a full return to learning and research on all our campuses.
- Students can expect to:
 - Return to campus from 20th September for continuing students and from 27th September for first year students.
