

Jobs Stimulus Eligibility Criteria

Academic Entry Criteria

In the first instance, all applicants must satisfy the minimum academic criteria as set out for each course/module. They are as follows:

Level 6 Module – Academic Entry Requirements

Minimum Leaving Certificate entry requirement grade O6/H7 or higher in 5 Leaving Certificate subjects including Mathematics and English or Irish with a minimum of 160 points.

- OR a Pass in any QQI FET major award at level 5 or 6
- OR Mature applicants (age 23 on or before the 1st January) do not have to meet the Leaving Certificate entry requirements/points, but are considered on an individual basis (previous education, work experience and demonstration of ability and competence to undertake the programme).

Mature applicants may be invited to interview which will be used to rank applicants where demand exceeds the available places on the programme.

- or Applicants may be considered for admission based on recognition of prior learning (RPL) in accordance with the institute's recognition of prior learning policy (RPL).

Level 7 Module – Academic Entry Requirements

Candidates must hold a QQI Level 6 major award in a cognate discipline or equivalent.

Students must meet the entry requirements as indicated in GMIT's Academic Code of Practice No. 4 (Access, Transfer and Progression), at any given time.

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) can be used as a means to gain entry to the programme, or gain exemptions in accordance with Code of Practice No. 6 (Policy and Procedures for the Recognition of Prior Learning). Prior learning can be certified or experiential, and will be assessed in accordance with the code.

Level 8 Module - Academic Entry Requirements

Candidates must hold a QQI Level 7 major award in a cognate discipline or equivalent.

Students must meet the entry requirements as indicated in GMITs Academic Code of Practice No. 4 (Access, Transfer and Progression), at any given time.

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) can be used as a means to gain entry to the programme, or gain exemptions in accordance with Code of Practice No. 6 (Policy and Procedures for the Recognition of Prior Learning). Prior learning can be certified or experiential, and will be assessed in accordance with the code.

Level 9 Module – Academic Entry Requirements

Candidates must hold a QQI Level 8 Bachelor (Honours) degree, minimum 2.2 Honours, in a cognate discipline or equivalent.

Students must meet the entry requirements as indicated in GMITs Academic Code of Practice No. 4 (Access, Transfer and Progression), at any given time.

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) can be used as a means to gain entry to the programme, or gain exemptions in accordance with Code of Practice No. 6 (Policy and Procedures for the Recognition of Prior Learning). Prior learning can be certified or experiential, and will be assessed in accordance with the code.
